The Cranch Endowment

The question was asked at the Annual Meeting as to what the restrictions are on the Cranch Fund. That fund was established by the late George and Evelyn Cranch to help maintain the church and cover certain operating expenses. They may not be used for salaries, payments to higher bodies of the Presbyterian Church, or missions outside the local community.

Communion Procedures:

Marie Loudon-Hanes and Elders and/or Deacons will serve Communion April 14 and April 17. We are asking that people come down the center aisle when they are ready. There will be hand sanitizer on each side of the aisles. Each person will be given a wafer. Elders or Deacons will stand at each side with the trays with cups of juice. Each person will pick up one cup of juice without touching anything else. Someone will stand to each side with a place for disposal of the empty cups. Each person will go left or right and around back to their seat. Persons who are not able to come forward may stay in their seats and the elements will be brought to them.

One Great Hour of Sharing

Around the world, millions of people lack access to sustainable food sources, clean water, sanitation, opportunity and education. The three programs supported by *One Great Hour of Sharing* (OGHS) are: Presbyterian Disaster Assistance (PDA) - Works alongside communities as they find hope and recover after the devastation of human-caused or natural disasters as well as support for refugees. PDA receives 32% of funds raised.

Presbyterian Hunger Program (PHP) - Takes action to alleviate hunger, care for creation along with the systematic causes of poverty so all may be fed. PHP receives 36% of fund raised.

Self-Development of People (SDOP) - Invests in communities responding to their experiences of poverty, oppression and injustice. It educates Presbyterians about the impact of these issues. SDOP receives 32% of fund raised.

These programs work in different ways to serve individuals and communities in need. Their work fits together to provide people with safety, sustenance and hope. In fact, OGHS is the largest, single way that all Presbyterians come together every year to work for a better world.

We will be collecting the OGHS offering on Easter Sunday, April 17, 2022.
